2012 Third (3rd) Quarter Report (Narrative)
for the Period **01 July through 30 September 2012**

A. PRBoA Meeting/s Held

For the period 01 July 1 through 30 September 2012, the PRBoA officially met on various dates i.e. on at least six (6) separate occasions, at the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) and elsewhere to discuss pending matters on the implementation and enforcement of **R.A. No. 9266** (The Architecture Act of 2004, its 2004 IRR and derivative regulations) and related urgent matters affecting the regulation of the architecture profession that need to be addressed the soonest.

B. FLEA

In September 2012, the PRBoA and the Commission jointly prepared the materials for the late October 2012 Foreign Licensure Examination for Architects (FLEA) to be held at four (4) test sites in the Middle East i.e. Riyadh and Al-Khobar (KSA), Doha (Qatar) and Abu Dhabi (UAE). The release of the results are targeted for early November 2012.

C. Review of/ Hearings for/ Decision on Docketed Administrative Cases at the PRC

There were 8 administrative cases reviewed and about 9 hearings attended by the PRBoA at the PRC Legal and Investigation Division (LID). Orders and/or decisions for 5 cases were also released during the 3rd quarter of 2012. There are approx. 42 pending administrative cases against registered and licensed architects (RLAs) generally involving complaints pertaining to gross negligence/ malpractice, dishonorable/ unethical/ unprofessional conduct and immorality. A substantial number of the docketed cases involve construction activities/ contracts by RLAs.

D. Monitoring of the Full Implementation and Enforcement of R.A. No. 9266 (The Architecture Act of 2004), of the Various Legislative Initiatives that Shall Materially Affect Said Law and of Court Decisions in Pending Cases Involving Efforts by Certain Groups of Civil Engineers (CEs) to Co-opt the Practice of Architecture, Specifically the Preparation, Signing and Sealing of Architectural Documents

The PRBoA has consistently monitored developments concerning the full implementation and enforcement of **R.A. No. 9266**, its 2004 IRR and derivative regulations (DRs). During the 3rd Quarter of 2012, Members of the PRBoA were less active in both Houses of Congress, but nonetheless still conducted monitoring activities, issuing calls/ notices to and conducting online and face-to-face discussions among RLAs, coordination with the concerned Senate/ House of Representative Committees, filing position papers or comments and following up developments on the following bills:

- (i) Pending Bills at the Senate at Committee level (hearings and Technical Working Group/ TWG meetings held) :
- (i) two (2) bills on civil engineering (CE);

- (ii) three (3) bills on the creation of a new Department (a major line agency), with an approved Senate version already being readied for the Bicameral Conference Committee Meeting; and
- (iii) two (2) bills on continuing professional education/ development (CPE/D);
- (ii) Pending Bills/ Resolution at the House of Representatives :
 - 1) four (4) bills on civil engineering (CE); and
 - 2) a House Committee Resolution to allow more foreign participation in architectural and other professional firms.

During the 3rd Quarter of 2012, the PRBoA was less active at both Houses of Congress and in the executive branch in following up its crafted bills to help address the practice environment of RLAs in the country (+/-30,000 registrants and +/-14,000 PRC ID card holders as of date), to wit:

- 1) repeal of P.D. No. 1096, otherwise known as the 1977 National Building Code of the Philippines (NBCP);

*Note: By the end of September 2011, the PRBoA completed its first draft of the one hundred forty (140)-page "light green" **repeal** bill for P.D. No. 1096 (the 1977 NBCP), which proposes to substantially overhaul the 35-year old law. Copies of the bill have been disseminated to possible sponsors in both Houses of Congress and to RLA-stakeholders as well as to selected RLPs from the allied professions. A hardcopy of said bill has already been personally furnished DPWH Secretary Rogelio Singson by the PRBoA on 04 October 2011. The DPWH is the primary agency tasked with the implementation and enforcement of P.D. No. 1096.*

- 2) the creation of a new Department (a major line agency) that shall hopefully take over full jurisdiction over all buildings on Philippine soil (from the DPWH);
- 3) the full professionalization of the local government position (LGU) position of Local Building Official (LBO) and Assistant Building Official (ABO);
- 4) severe penalties for erring building officials (BOs);
- 5) continuing professional education/ development (CPE/D);
- 6) Non-Mobile Billboards;
- 7) Anti-Graft Law; and
- 8) Consulting Services Board.

Some of the foregoing bills are still under review by the legal staff of certain Senators and Congressmen or were already independently crafted and filed by some lawmakers.

Among the key developments on the legal front being consistently monitored by the PRBoA are:

- 1) the matter of the **preparation/ signing/ dry sealing of ARCHITECTURAL** documents as part of building permit application applications required by the DPWH through the LGU Offices of Acting Building Officials (ABOs); in the past, the PRBoA has been very consistent in reminding/ warning senior national and local government officials of the mandated and sworn duties of their subordinate officials to fully implement the **multiple provisions** of **R.A. No. 9266 and** under Secs. 302.3 & 4 of the 2004 Revised IRR of P.D. No. 1096, otherwise known as the 1977 National Building Code of the Philippines (NBCP) that limit the **preparation/ signing/ dry sealing of ARCHITECTURAL plans and documents** only to registered and licensed architects (RLAs), violations of which merit stiff administrative and criminal penalties under various laws; with the January 2012 Decision of the Court of Appeals (CA) **REVERSING** an early 2008 RTC Decision on Secs. 302.3 & 4 of the 2004 Revised IRR of P.D. No. 1096 (which also limit to Architects the acts of signing/ sealing **architectural** documents), the RLAs suffer only a **momentary** setback; the RLAs, through the integrated and accredited professional organization of architects (**IAPOA**, more popularly known as the United Architects of the Philippines (**UAP**), have seasonably filed a Motion for Reconsideration (**MR**) with the CA, apparently making the **January 2012 CA Decision **NEITHER FINAL NOR EXECUTORY****; even if the CA affirms its January 2012 Decision in resolving the RLA MR, the **case, which is NOT about R.A. No. 9266** shall still be elevated to the Supreme

Court (SC), which shall render the **final judgment**; as such and since **R.A. No. 9266 is a valid and subsisting law**, there is apparently **NO legal impediment** to the full Government implementation and enforcement of **R.A. No. 9266**, its IRR and derivative regulations at present, particularly of the provisions that purposely **LIMIT/ RESTRICT** the **preparation/ signing/ dry sealing of ARCHITECTURAL plans/ documents** only to **RLAs** i.e. **there is NO TRO, NO injunction and NO pending constitutional question before any Philippine Court on any of the provisions of R.A. No. 9266, a law that has been in full effect since 10 April 2004**; as such, **NO** other registered and licensed professional (**RLP**), particularly the concerned civil engineers (**CEs**) who insist on their supposed “right” to practice architecture, can continually lay claim to the **exclusive professional privilege** relating to the preparation of **architectural documents**, until the anticipated SC Decision (to be promulgated at a later time) attains finality i.e. assuming the SC also favors the **CEs** on the matter of the signing and sealing of **architectural documents**, or until a new law is passed by the State expressly granting **CEs** such a privilege, heretofore reserved only for **RLAs** who have all been duly qualified under law i.e. **RLAs** possessing full academic training in architecture (a **B.S. Architecture degree**) and passing a **State licensure examination that is one hundred percent (100%) about the planning and design of buildings** (the **LEA**), which **CEs** do **NOT** possess;

Note : In a very recent public forum, a senior DPWH official announced that up to seventy six percent (76%) of all buildings/ habitable structures (including residences) that have been processed/ approved by LGU Acting Building Officials (ABOs) nationwide apparently had architectural documents bearing the signatures and dry seals of civil engineers (CEs), a very clear and willful violation of multiple provisions under R.A. No. 9266 by incumbent Government officials. This means that for the architectural documentation (i.e. architectural plan and design preparation) of 3 of every 4 buildings in the PH, NO registered and licensed architect (RLA) was involved in the certification of the architectural documents and in the ensuing building permit documentation/ application activities.

It has also become all too apparent that to get around R.A. No. 9266, and to prematurely implement a January 2012 Court of Appeals (CA) decision that shall still be decided with finality by the Supreme Court (SC), some ABOs or Building Officials (BOs) or Offices of the Building Official (OBOs) of certain LGUs are apparently already accepting CE signatures and dry seals over architectural documents or on building application permits with the signing/ sealing CE's profession being identified as “Architectural Engineer”, a non-existent regulated profession on Philippine (PH) soil. These are apparently graft-ridden practices or acts of incumbent Government officials in league with some CEs, for which both sets of entities are punishable under at least three (3) PH Anti-Graft laws (R.A. Nos. 3019, 6713 and 9485).

The PRBoA is still in active coordination with two (2) of its counsels during the 3rd quarter of 2012 i.e. relative to the possible filing of a separate/ independent legal action with respect to R.A. No. 9266 and/or the filing of administrative and/or criminal cases against agents of the Court who intercalated/ who continues to rely on the intercalated (falsified) Sec. 302 of P.D. No. 1096 i.e. purporting that civil engineers (CEs) can sign and seal architectural documents when the law very clearly does NOT say that. A third (3rd) PRBoA counsel is still separately working on the November 2009 complaint the PRBoA filed against the former DPWH Secretary, two (2) DPWH Undersecretaries, a law book author and the Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers (PICE) and on other pertinent cases involving the PRBoA or its Acting Chairman before the Office of the Ombudsman. Two (2) more pro-bono senior external counsels also periodically assist the PRBoA on other legal matters.

- 2) on the separate matter of the preparation/ signing/ dry sealing of “subdivision” plan documents as part of development applications required by the Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board (HLURB); with the firm PRC position (stated in its **letter dated 01 Feb 2007 to the HLURB**) as regards the matter of the signatory to “subdivision” plans, it may now be the opportune time to officially discuss the matter among the four (4) professional regulatory boards (PRBs) involved i.e. PRBoA(rchitecture), PRBoE(nvironmental) P(lanning), PRBoC(ivil) E(ngineering) and PRBoG(eodetic) E(ngineering), possibly in a non-confrontational manner, so that the proper nomenclature of the pertinent site/ subdivision planning documents could be agreed upon and would therefore serve as the primary guide for the HLURB in its future policy-making functions; otherwise the PRBoA must seriously consider a similar campaign for implementation and enforcement of **R.A. No. 9266** provisions that limit to RLAs the preparation/ signing/ dry sealing of architectural documents in the form of physical or site plans in general i.e. specifically subdivision plans.
- (iii) Information on the RTC Manila Branch 32’s March 2012 Decision on an Indirect Contempt Petition filed by the PICE in mid-2007 against the Acting PRBoA Chair and a co-respondent RLA from the Bicol region has been electronically furnished the PRC at end-March 2012; the Office of the Solicitor-General (OSG), representing the Respondent PRBoA Chair has filed its Motion for Reconsideration (MR) dated 26 March 2012 and its Petition for Review at the Court of Appeals (CA) in June 2012; and
- (iv) Information on the Office of the Ombudsman (OO) 2011 DENIAL of the PICE Motion for Reconsideration (MR) on the OO’s 2010 Dismissal of the 2010 PICE Complaint filed against the PRBoA Acting Chair has also been electronically furnished the PRC at end-March 2012.

The PRBoA is also presently monitoring the implementation and enforcement of the following provisions of **R.A. No. 9266**:

- 1) registration of architectural firms under Sec. 37;
- 2) application, processing and issuance of temporary special permits (TSPs) for foreign architects (FAs) working on projects on Philippine soil under Sec. 38;
- 3) continuing professional development/ education (CPD/E) under Secs. 7 (i) and 28 of R.A. No. 9266 and professional specialization for RLAs; the IAPOA-UAP was accredited by the CPE Council for Architecture as a CPE Provider on 07 August 2009;
- 4) updating of the B.S. Architecture curriculum together with the CHED Technical Panel for Architecture, where the CODHASP and the IAPOA-UAP are represented;
- 5) the intellectual property rights (IPR) of **RLAs** to their crafted **architectural** documents (which are apparently misappropriated/ illegally used by unscrupulous entities whenever the same are submitted under various governmental permitting processes ;
- 6) the filling up of all national and local positions that require the training and expertise of **RLAs** i.e. specifically the work of ABOs or ABO architectural review staff in LGUs with or without ABOs or Offices of ABOs, a provision under R.A. No. 9266 that has been in full effect since 10 April 2007; and
- 7) preparations attendant to the filing of criminal and/or administrative complaints at various venues against offending national and/or local government officials and the private entities who have directly benefitted from official violations of R.A. No. 9266, etc.

The PRBoA has also reminded stakeholders that the IAPOA-UAP jurisdiction is over natural persons registered and licensed to practice architecture under R.A. No. 9266. Juridical persons such as architectural sole proprietorships, partnerships and corporations (and even joint ventures and associations/ consortia) are not under IAPOA-UAP jurisdiction and should be part of another SEC-registered entity (just as the old CCAPP which was retired in 2006).

While architectural and engineering (A&E) firms are also not fully regulated by the PRBoA, which is limited by law to regulating registered architectural firms (RAFs), the activities of the registered and licensed architects (RLAs) and/or of unregistered persons performing architectural services for such A&E firms are still under PRBoA jurisdiction.

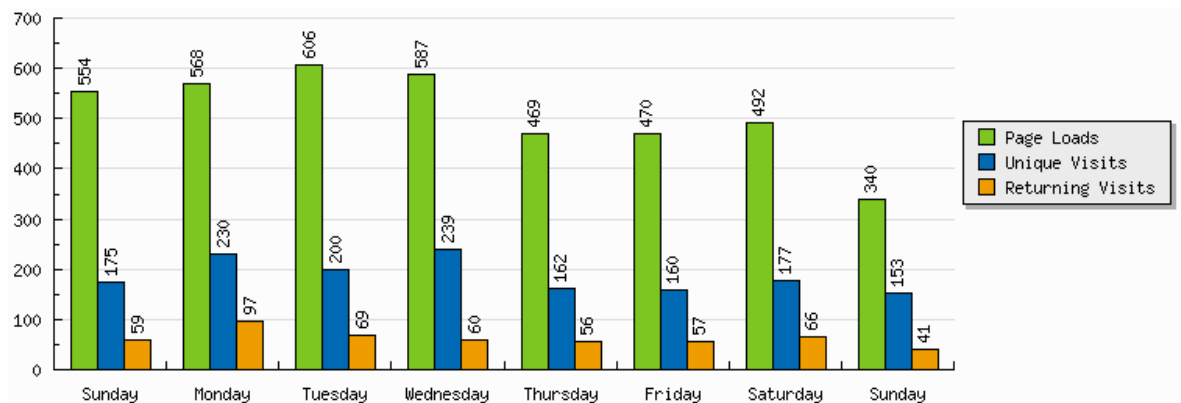
E. General Dissemination of Information on R.A. No. 9266

Over the period July through September 2012, the PRBoA has actively taken part in (or has attended) various activities relative to the general dissemination of information on **R.A. No. 9266** and the proposed laws and executive issuances that affect it e.g. information exchanges at its various mailboxes and through its website at www.architectureboard.ph i.e. messages, clarifications, statements, general regulation documents, etc., direct mailing to parties (electronic and courier); fora on addressing graft and corruption, general architecture advocacy meetings, meetings/ conferences with various groups of **RLAs**, etc.

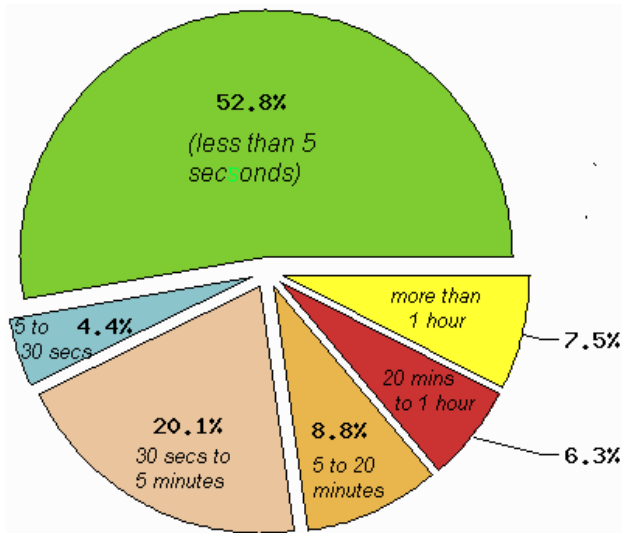
The PRBoA website continues to serve as a major platform for PRBoA advocacies, which now include the need to correct many provisions of the **R.A. No. 7160** (The Local Government Code of 1991) to make the same fully conform to the correct professional practices enshrined under valid and subsisting professional regulatory laws (**PRLs**, such as **R.A. No. 9266**) i.e. particularly Sec. 477 of **R.A. No. 7160** which should already be repealed as it permits Municipal/ City Engineers to assume the post of Acting Building Officials (**ABOs**), an appointive position that rightfully belongs to RLAs per Sec. 35 of **R.A. No. 9266**.

By the end of September 2012, about one million seventy thousand (+/-**1,075,000**) pageloads/visits to the PRBoA website have been logged (since mid-2008, or approx. 255,000 pageloads/visits annually). Again, while the IAPOA-UAP website is presently linked to the new PRC website, the PRBoA website is still not until end-September 2012.

Most of the PRBoA website visitors outside the country come from the Middle East, East Asia, Indian sub-continent, Southeast Asia, parts of Africa, Oceania, and from many parts of North America and Europe. Hereafter are some graphical information concerning the recent PRBoA website usage (daily visits and visit length) during the 3rd quarter of 2012.

F. Liaison and Current Relationship with the Accredited IAPOA (UAP) and with Other Associations of Architects (OAAs) and Stakeholders

During the 3rd Quarter of 2012, the PRBoA has attended (and actively taken part in) the various activities of the IAPOA-UAP and other architectural organizations (PIA, AAIF, CODHASP, The Architects’ Council, etc.) pertaining to **R.A. No. 9266** implementation and enforcement in the Philippines or have attended to matters concerning the PRBoA relations with said entities.

Of particular import were the series of meetings between the IAPOA-UAP, the PRBoA and the PRC during which discussions focused/ touched on several issues/ concerns that relate to the rollouts of the ASEAN Architect and APEC Architect programs.

G. Liaison with the PRC and PAPRB

During the 3rd quarter of 2012, the PRBoA has actively supported the various activities carried out by the PRC with the Philippine Association of Professional Regulatory Boards (PAPRB), including multi-sectoral and cross-sectoral events, as well as those relating to planning activities for the proposed Professional Summit on 18 and 19 October 2012. Of particular importance were the series of consultations, meetings and workshops concerning the preparation and refinement of the Architecture Roadmap.

H. ASEAN Architects (AAs)

In late September 2012, the PRBoA Acting Chair attended the five (5) separate meetings at the 71st Meeting of the ASEAN Coordinating Committee on Services (CCS-71) i.e. the 14th ASEAN Architects Council (AAC) Meeting, the 2nd AAC Roundtable and Networking Discussion, the 1st ASEAN Architecture Education Working Group (AAEWG) Meeting as lone Philippine representative as well as the CCS Business Services Working Group (SWG) Meeting (as 1 of 4 Philippine representatives) and one of several CCS Meetings (as observer) over the period 26 through 28 September 2012.

A separate PRBoA report shall be transmitted to the Office of the PRC Chairperson concerning the CCS-71 meetings, specifically as regards the meetings of the ASEAN Architects Council (AAC).

CCS-72 (including 2 to 3 AAC Meetings) shall be held in Brunei Darussalam in mid-January 2013.
